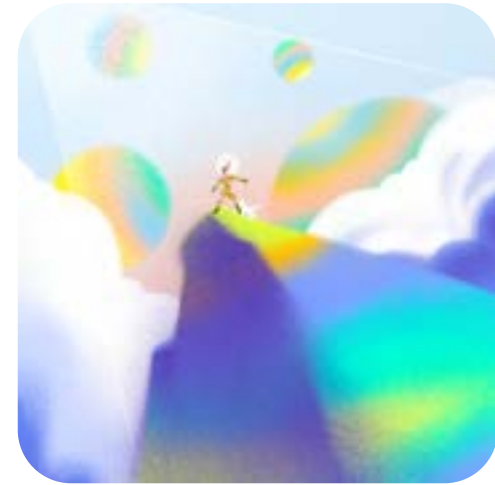

Uranus

You'll walk out of this phase with a sense of naivete, wondering where all the time has gone, and with a new appreciation for this wonderful life we're given.

Mercury

A shaman has mastered the magic of the four elements, as represented by this card. With his skill, knowledge, and willpower he can manifest anything he wants in this world. He is full of creative power, he is ready to perform a ritual to fulfill his dream. The presence of the shaman in a reading is a confirmation from the universe that you can do it. No more doubt about your ability, success is right in front of you, as long as you are willing to act.

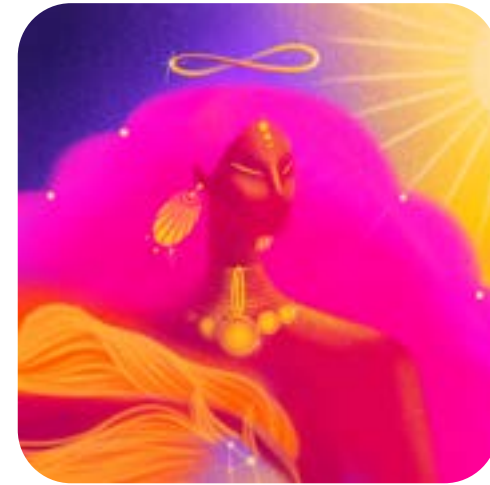
The Chariot

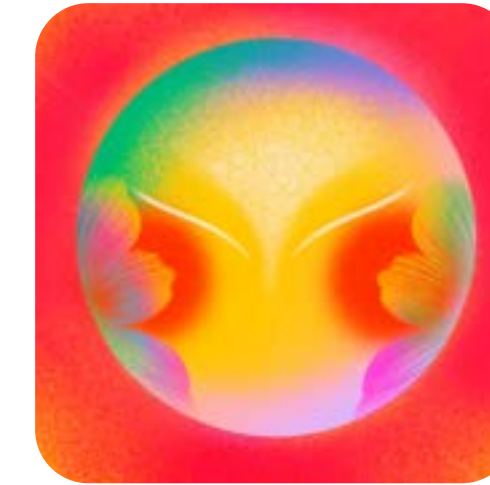

King of Wands

As an action-oriented person, you won't find him sitting around for too long thinking. He is always working on something. The dark side of his nature is self-centered, lack of patience, controlling, demeaning and bad temper.



King of Cups

His sincerity, empathy, and warmth demonstrate that he is an emotionally mature individual who understands people's suffering, since he himself has experienced them all. He is able to tap into the spiritual side of all matters, and bridge emotions with reasons. He displays calmness, compassion, empathy, and tolerance. Such characteristics would make him an excellent spiritual guide. When he chooses to stand in the dark, he can be very manipulative, dishonest, and deceitful.



King of Swords

The impersonation of logic in scientific thinking. His thoughts and knowledge are abundant. There are many qualities he possesses, including self-discipline, principle, system, routine, intelligence, rationality, logic, mental power, and authority. One of his fun sides is that he knows a lot of random fun facts. He is good at providing accessible solutions to help you overcome obstacles in your life. His honest opinion is there when you are ready to hear it. It's not a good idea to turn to him for emotional comfort in tough times since he might not know how to handle emotions, you will only get logical steps on how to solve your problem.



King of Pentacles

Known as a trustworthy and successful businessman, he is resourceful, principled, and successful. He is serious about his wealth and business. Focus, determination, and perseverance are his virtues. If he makes a decision, he will follow through with it, regardless of whether he builds an empire or cuts personal ties. Through hard work, he is determined to build his own kingdom and legacy. It is she who appears in a reading to challenge you to take control over your life. Her behavior can be chaotic at times. Her temper can be difficult to control when she's challenged.

Queen of Cups

Dreamy and beautiful. Imagination is embodied in her. She is the ultimate archetype of the divine female. She follows her intuition, and she is always in the know. People are not threatened by her presence, instead, they can experience healing as she uses her healing power to wash over all wounds. There are times when she has trouble grounding herself in reality because she spends too much time in her imagination. It is possible that her kindness leads to her being taken advantage of.



Queen of Swords

Any problem can be seen through her eyes. Smart, independent, sophisticated, chatty, quirky, open-minded, and forthright. She is here to solve problems and defend those who are vulnerable. When she thinks something is outdated, she is not afraid of cutting ties, and she marches forward leaving the past behind. No one will fool her, she will call out any wrongdoing. In a low vibration frequency, she might be manipulative, argue for the sake of winning, cold, and defensive.



Queen of Pentacles

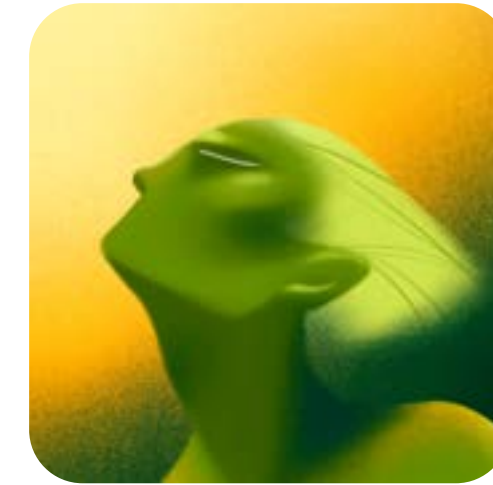
Knight of Cups

Page of Wands

Page of Cups

An intuitive messenger, soft, loving, and positive. She is very romantic and dreamy. Her presence is positive, soothing and inspiring. She sometimes lacks emotional boundaries, is easily influenced, and is prone to changing her mind.



Page of Swords

She acts like a rushing wind. Her presence demonstrated how a person can harness a vast amount of energy and use it for logical, sharp, and insightful conversation and projects. Be cautious of sharp energies that could appear harsh or cold.



Page of Pentacles

Firmly rooted on earth. She is a good student, plans carefully, and doesn't fear hard work. Divination is her passion, earth materials are her favorite resources for creating magic, and she knows how to make her dream a reality. She can be stubborn at times, follows rules strictly, and maybe lacking in imagination.

Ace of Wands

A new cosmic ignition has just begun. Symbolizing burgeoning potential, new ideas, opportunities, and plans, the Ace of Wands represents possibilities. Nothing is impossible. This card could represent a start to a new project, a new approach in life and work, or discover your own creative spark. It indicates more movement, drive, and focus on one's goals.



Two of Wands

0-10 degrees of Aries, Mars in Aries

You are being presented with a new path by the Two of Wands. Cosmic energies are at work. This path has tremendous power. It takes courage and curiosity to embark on this path. Additionally, it indicates overseas travel, sudden departures, and deciding whether to stay or go. A Two of Wands is also a card about strength, which can be found in harmony, rule, justice, courage, boldness, resolve, ambition, and restlessness.



Three of Wands

10-20 degrees of Aries, Sun in Aries

The seed has been planted. There is much planning yet to be done before the big event. In the Three of Wands, establishing power and achieving hope were represented. Also symbolized by the Three of Wands is success after struggle. With the project you are working on, you have the capacity to bring pride, wealth, and power to your life.



Four of Wands

20-30 degrees of Aries, Venus In Aries

As a result of hard work and removing obstacles to success, the completion of a project or milestone is represented by this card. Your efforts could be rewarded, or it may be a source of good news for the people involved with the questions. It's time to celebrate. It could also mean a group celebration or a wedding. It can also symbolize a successful teamwork environment and a happy home environment in tarot.

Five of Wands

0-10 degrees of Leo, Saturn in Leo

There are too many ideas at the table, people are disagreeing with each other, and each side refuses to budge. Several factors are at play, making the individual defensive or rushing to make a decision. A person should be cautious when this card appears in a reading. Irritation and frustration are usually the result of clashing egos or personalities. People around you might not cooperate or they might take actions against your will, and you may also feel out of control.



Six of Wands

10-20 degrees of Leo, Jupiter in Leo

This is, in essence, a card full of cheering energy and accolades. This is both motivating and inspiring. When this card appears in a reading, it represents campaigns that are winning and being successful. It can also mean that there is a sense of optimism with a feeling that everything is moving in the right direction.



Seven of Wands

20-30 degrees of Leo, Mars in Leo

In this card, you are demonstrating the ability to stand up to the opposition, be assertive, and maintain control in the face of harassment. Having the inner fortitude to let no one influence your decisions or cause you to change your mind regardless of their attempts to do so. The Seven of Wands represents standing up against the odds and holding out when the odds are against you.



Eight of Wands

0-10 degrees of Sagittarius, Mercury in Sagittarius

New phases or times bring excitement and optimism, but they can also cause confusion and uncertainty. Now is a great time to follow your gut feeling about a decision. Be confident that everything will turn out as planned. The Eight of Wands card represents a surge of communications, long-distance travel, action, excitement, and taking off on a trip spontaneously.

Nine of Wands

10-20 degrees of Sagittarius, Moon in Sagittarius

Tired, drained of energy, courage, persistence, perseverance. You are almost there. You've made a lot of progress, but there's still a bit of stamina left in us. You are going to need to take care of your body and mind, as we have a few more battles on the horizon. This card is asking you to learn from past failures in order to succeed in the future.



Ten of Wands

20-30 degrees of Sagittarius, Saturn in Sagittarius

As this card indicates, you are currently feeling overwhelmed by everything going on around you. This card is asking you to examine the responsibilities that you are taking on with your journey. Does it make sense to take on all of them? At times, it's okay to let something go. As well as indicating you are almost "home," the north star on this card is leading you to a healing place for your soul to renew.

Ace of Cups

Ace of Cups indicates an overflow of positive feelings and emotions, usually associated with love, empathy, compassion, and happiness. Now is the perfect time to put yourself out there, to form new friendships, trust that you will be greeted with kindness and receptivity.



Two of Cups

0-10 degrees of Cancer, Venus in Cancer

A smooth energy flow takes place between two souls when they have a divine connection. You are experiencing harmony at the moment. In general, this card symbolizes unity, love, and harmony in romantic relationships, but it can also depict harmony, respect, and appreciation between friends and partners. Just like the Two of Swords, this card signifies equality and balance, but on an emotional level.



Three of Cups

10-20 degrees of Cancer, Mercury in Cancer

A group of like-minded individuals comes together to celebrate. It's a card of happy times, but they won't last forever. The card represents parties, festivals, and other similar events. Good feeling and uplifting energy are associated with the card. Perhaps you can look forward to a happy occurrence.



Four of Cups

20-30 degrees of Cancer, Moon in Cancer

It shows some regret and remorse in this card. In certain situations, you may be inclined to victimize yourself. Alternatively, you may just be bored with the way your life is going right now. If you shift your focus and look for positive aspects, you will find that happiness is right around the corner and you just didn't look for it. Similarly, it can imply nostalgia and daydreaming.

Five of Cups

0-10 degrees of Scorpio, Mars in Scorpio

It signifies the end of harmony and pleasure. Breaking up with a partner, disappointment in love, the death of a friendship, or being hurt by an unkind person. It can cause a lot of anxiety and depression for a person. A reading of this card indicates that a person must undergo a healing phase in order to recover from mental trauma.



Six of Cups

10-20 degrees of Scorpio, Sun in Scorpio

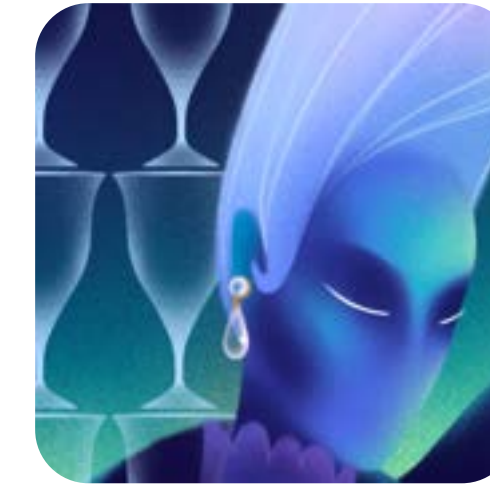
The feeling of being a child. It's a card of nostalgia and happy childhood memories. Thinking about someone from the past or reminiscing about the past is represented by this card. In addition, it carries an air of childish innocence and youthfulness. Playfulness, innocence, goodwill, and sharing could all be represented by it. At the extreme, it can also be seen as being childish or immature.



Seven of Cups

20-30 degrees of Scorpio, Venus in Scorpio

Here, a lot of options are available to you. To achieve focus, you must narrow them down. Additionally, this card indicates the blindness and uncertainty of a situation. There are a lot of illusions all around you, so maybe take a moment to pause and think realistically about what you can do. In addition, this card indicates that you might put too much energy into imagining your goal rather than taking action towards it.



Eight of Cups

0-10 degrees of Pisces, Saturn in Pisces

It signifies abandoning a long-term project. Escapism and disappointment are also associated with it. It is possible that exhaustion and fatigue led to the abandonment. Taking this step requires courage, decrement, and the ability to face yourself in the mirror.



Nine of Cups

10-20 degrees of Pisces, Jupiter in Pisces

You will receive what you wish for. This card signifies that you will emerge from your current situation and reach a high point in your life soon. Your dream has come true, so you are filled with joy and happiness. Moreover, your efforts won't go unnoticed as this also signifies recognition and fame, boosting your self-esteem.



Ten of Cups

20-30 degrees of Pisces, Mars in Pisces

Having this card in a reading is a positive thing. It brings joy, happiness, and blessing. It's a great time to look back on what you've accomplished emotionally, and make plans for the future. As this card shows up, it's a good time to rest and rejuvenate at home. The term "home" can refer to your actual place of residence, or it can also refer to a place where you feel at home or one that reminds you of home. To celebrate this moment, surround yourself with the people you love, your friends, and your family.

Ace of Swords

The cosmic force of logic and thought. Invocation of truth. It symbolizes the power that can summon both good and evil. Ace of Swords can cut through all the attachments that are trapping a person in a situation. Stop putting off the inevitable, face your truth. You are encouraged to make logical and correct decisions, being assertive, fair and authoritative.



Two of Swords

0-10 degrees of Libra, Moon in Libra

It takes tremendous strength to keep the balance between two opposing mental forces. This card represents a challenging situation. The woman in this card is trying to maintain her balance. While things are peaceful now, she doesn't yet know that movements are on the way. This card represents justice, arrangement, unselfishness and giving in since it is associated with the Libra Constellation.



Three of Swords

10-20 degrees of Libra, Saturn in Libra

A healing process is taking place to heal the wounded heart. There is sorrow, tears, and unhappiness associated with separation and disruption. Meanwhile, healing energy flows into your heart from the moon. The moon on this card represents healing on an emotional level. If this card appears in your reading, it means that you need some time and space to heal, it's not yet time for action.



Four of Swords

20-30 degrees of Libra, Jupiter in Libra

Taking a break after a long journey. Recovery, a tranquil time, and rest is portrayed in this card. The future looks bright. Further, abundance and security in material terms are indications of healing, as they permit the process.

Five of Swords

0-10 degrees of Aquarius, Venus in Aquarius

Feeling defeated, having to face one's failure. The anxiety, difficulty that comes from a battle or argument is symbolized by this card. This card might also indicate that you are dealing with an unreliable and ungrateful person.

10-20 degrees of Aquarius, Mercury in Aquarius

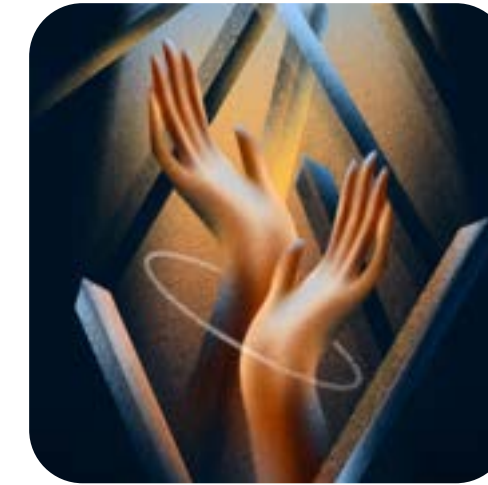

Seven of Swords

Eight of Swords

0-10 degrees of Gemini, Jupiter in Gemini

Having this card could mean that a person feels trapped emotionally or physically. You can see there's an energy chain created by the negative thought forms, but it does not have a physical form. Those who feel trapped have the option of unchaining themselves. Remember, there is always free will.



Nine of Swords

10-20 degree Gemini, Mars in Gemini

Those swords are attacking the glowing sun inside the being from the outside. This card asks if you have a lot of unhappiness that is dimming your glow? Your mind is drained from all the analyzing and overthinking. Life can be difficult. It's a condition of being a human. Choose hope, it's always there, waiting for you, ahead. Let go of fear, nightmare, regrets, and despair. Remove the swords and shine once more.

20-30 degrees of Gemini, Sun in Gemini

You may feel that you have hit rock bottom. As the card shows, your hope is on the horizon, but before you begin your journey, you still have work to do to remove all the negative feelings such as betrayal, backstabbing, being attacked, and self-victimization.

Two of Pentacles

0-10 degrees of Capricorn, Jupiter in Capricorn

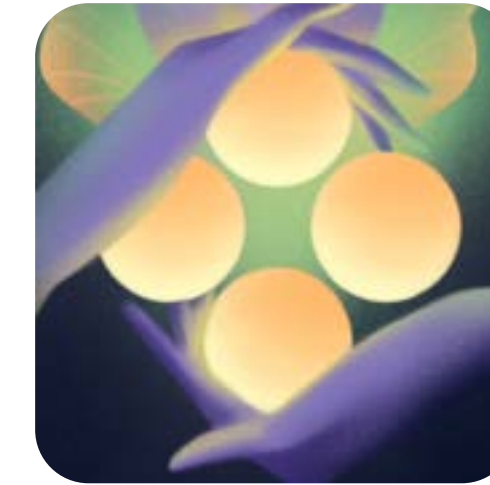
